Introducing Pasic




For nearly 50 years we've helped families through the trauma of a child's cancer diagnosis.

How we help

When parents hear the news that a child has cancer their world seems like it's falling apart. Normal family life stops. Brothers and sisters can feel confused and anxious. Parents struggle to hold everything together. We make sure they don't feel alone. We offer emotional, practical, and financial support to the whole family.

What does a Pasic Family Support Worker do?

- A friendly face on the hospital ward.
- Activities and trips for the whole family.
- Money and supermarket vouchers to help with the hidden cost of cancer.
- Counselling referrals for family members.
- Practical support to make hospital stays easier.
- Signposting to other charities, support services, information, and advice.
- Making memories and bereavement support when a child doesn't recover.



Learn more about the cause – Hopefully the difference you're making will inspire you




Training or preparation – As they say, failing to prepare is preparing to fail!
