## About the role

As one of eight Trustees, you'll work closely with fellow Board members, our Chair and CEO to provide strategic oversight and effective governance.

We're particularly interested in hearing from individuals with experience in areas such as law, charity or corporate governance, company secretarial practice, compliance or regulation or risk management.

Your expertise will help ensure Pasic continues to operate with strong governance and best practice as we grow. Alongside attending Board meetings, you'll provide occasional advice and guidance to the Chair and CEO on governance matters, supporting both the organisation and the Board in maintaining effective decision-making and good governance.

Previous trustee experience is not essential. We're looking for someone who shares our values, brings sound judgement and is keen to use their professional skills to support our mission.

## Time Commitment

You'll be expected to attend approximately six Board meetings each year, together with some preparation beforehand. There may also be opportunities to provide advice or guidance between meetings, particularly on governance matters, as the Chair, CEO or Board requires.

This role is voluntary. Travel and other reasonable expenses will be reimbursed.
